JESUS SAYS “THIS IS WHERE I WANT YOU”. I CAN'T EXPLAIN IT ANY OTHER WAY.

TESTIMONY 1: To commit myself to spend one hour a week in the presence of Jesus was one of the best commitments I have made of recent times. A time of stillness, contemplation, peace and reflection has made a difference to my life. I have grown more in closeness to Jesus. I feel more at peace in my life.

TESTIMONY 2: When I am before the Eucharist, I am struck with awe and wonder. I come broken and bruised. I bring Him my pain and longing, and He responds with peace and healing. It's incredible that He wants unworthy little me to be with perfect almighty Him for all eternity. How can I not want to love Him, be close to Him, and commune with the faithful in heaven and on earth. The Eucharist is the real presence of Christ - once you 'get it,' this procession we call life has meaning, hope and purpose.

TESTIMONY 3: Adoration for me has been a time of drawing closer to Our Lord in a completely different way from anything else I have experienced. It has been direct, intense and very personal to the extent of finding myself often unaware of other adorers. Jesus says to me "This is where I want you". I can't explain it any other way.

TESTIMONY 4: There has been a lot of things happen this year where I think God has been leading me to the point of participating in perpetual adoration. I have found that in the time I have started adoration things are happening in my life that I thought I would never do. God has been answering questions I didn't know I had and giving me peace about things I keep bugging Him about. I am at peace knowing that in his time he will answer those prayers and desires I have that I deeply want to be sorted out now.

TESTIMONY 5: I signed up for adoration after a friend encouraged me. In turn I encouraged my husband to sign up as well, so praise the Lord we did and therefore became committed to a few hours a week. Over the year my few hours have increased, yet so too has my spiritual growth and personal relationship with Christ. Furthermore what I do at adoration has changed as well; from going along with an arm's length of prayers to pray from the minute I got there to the minute I left, to just sitting in the presence of Christ silently reflecting. Although prayers are very good, it is hard to hear the voice of our Lord when you talk too much. Therefore one year on I am able to hear Christ speak in the depths of my heart, to initiate dialogue if required. The Gospel on Sunday May 11th was 'Jesus the Good Shepherd', part of which said *"The one who enters by the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. The gatekeeper opens the gate for him, and the sheep hear his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has brought out all his own, he goes ahead of them, and the sheep follow him because they know his voice."* (John 10:2-4 - NRSV). We know we are the sheep so isn't it our desire to hear the voice of the shepherd? I believe a good way to experience Christ in this way is giving Him one hour of your time, to adore His presence in the Monstrance.
