a second Adam to the fight and to the rescue came.

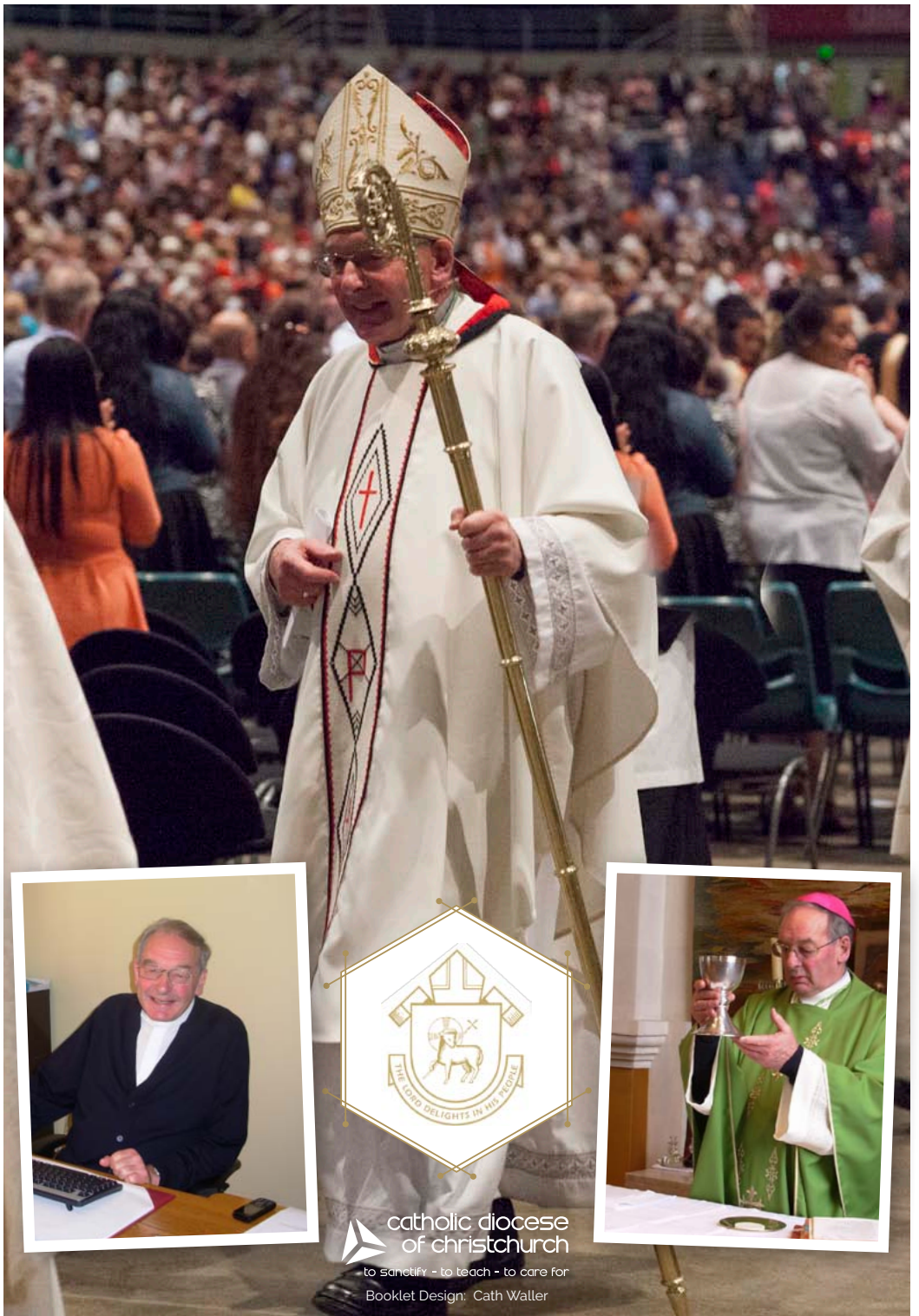
O wisest love! that flesh and blood, which did in Adam fail,
